
OverDrive Scavenger Hunt

3. Click on Collections again and under audiobooks click on "Always available audiobooks". What is the first audiobook listed?

4. Next, click on Teens and scroll down to "Enduring YA Books." Click on "See all." What is the title of the first book on page 3?

5. Go to page 4 of this search and click on the first title listed, "The Raven Boys." Click on "Listen to a Sample." How long is the sample for this audiobook?
