

Activity Idea

EARLY LITERACY ACTIVITIES

Recommended for Ages 2 – 5

These activities do not require any special materials. You can use any items you have at home that your children can count. Use your imaginations and have fun learning!

Instructions:

Math

- Sort toys into size or color before putting them away.
- Count small toys, crayons, or cereal pieces. Sort them into groups of five and count. Sort them into groups of ten and count. Practice counting to twenty, thirty, forty, or fifty.

Language Arts

- Instead of listening to music, sing together.
- Ask your child to tell you a funny story about an animal.

Science

- Take an ice cube out of the freezer and put it in a bowl. Ask your child what they think it will look like in ten minutes. Talk about what is happening.
