

Activity Idea

Memory Game

Recommended for Ages 3 – 12

Instructions and How to Play:

1. Cut out each individual piece on the next page and lay each piece face down on a table randomly.
2. Decide who is going to be the first player.
3. The first player will pick one square, turn it over, look at the shape on the square and see if they can find where the other matching shape is on the table by turning over a second square. If the player finds the matching shape, they get to keep those squares take another turn. If they don't find a match, they place both squares face down in the same place they picked them up and it is the next player's turn.
4. The next player will then take their turn, pick one square, turn it over, and then try to find the matching shape on another square. If they have a match they go again. If they do not have a match, place both squares face down in the same place they picked them up from on the table.
5. Keep repeating until all the matches have been found. The player that finds the most matches wins the game!
