LITTER BUGS

Recommended for Ages 5 – 8

You will need the following materials:

- Paper of any kind (newspaper, magazine paper, scratch paper preferred)
- Markers/crayons/pencils
- Glue/tape
- Scissors
- Leftover bottle caps (pen, marker and glue caps could work too) *optional*
- Q-tips or straws *optional*

Directions

Just in time for Earth Day, these litter bugs can be a perfect reminder of the importance of recycling and reusing materials. Ball up paper of your choice to make the body of your litter bug. You can make eyes, nose and a mouth using paper and crayons. Cut them out and glue or tape them to your bug. After that, use your imagination to make your litter bug as unique as you. Bottle caps can make good hats or feet. Q-tips or cut up straws can make good arms and legs. But really all you need is scratch paper to make whatever you want to add to your litter bug.
