Adjust the Anagram

Recommended for Ages 7 – 12

What is an Anagram?

An anagram is when you take a word or phrase and rearrange it using each letter once to make a new word or phrase. For example, Pam could be made into map or amp.

Use the clues below to rearrange the anagram word into the correct answer.

For our example above – Pam – a clue might say “a word to describe a picture of all the countries on Earth” = map. Try it with the words below! All answers are one word each.
