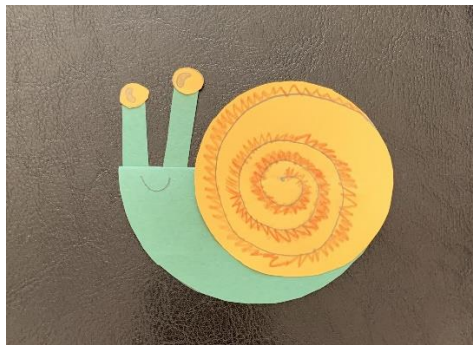


Activity Idea

SNAIL PAL

Recommended for Ages 4 – 6



Materials

- Two sheets of paper of different color
- Colored pencil/Crayon/Marker
- Scissors
- Glue

Directions

Shapes and patterns are all around you. Look around outside today and you might meet a snail!

Make your own Snail Pal by cutting two circles, one 7 inches and the other one 5 inches in diameter on the different colored sheet. Then fold the bigger circle in half and glue it together, making this the body. Take the smaller circle and draw a spiral shape beginning from the center and fanning out to reach the edge of the circle. With a colored pencil, color or marker, go along the spiral and create a zigzag pattern. Glue the smaller circle onto the body placing it where it looks like the shell. Then cut two narrow rectangles and glue them behind the flat edge of the body. With some leftover paper, draw, cut and glue two smaller oval shapes to be the eyes. Finish it by drawing pupils and a smile. Doesn't it feel great to practice your eye-hand coordination and differentiating between colors and sizes? Great job!
