- Colors/markers

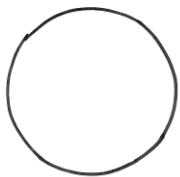
What are some types of lines?

There are straight lines, squiggly lines, thick lines, thin lines, spirals, broken lines, zig zags and many more. Below are some examples:

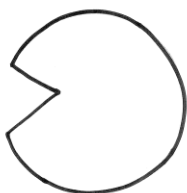


Today we are going to draw and decorate a fish using different lines.

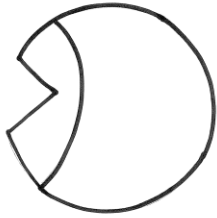
Using the pencil, start by drawing a circle.



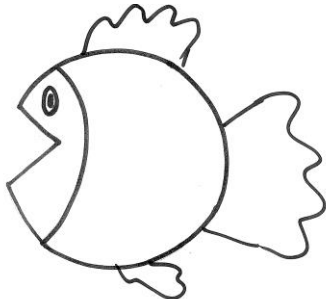
Then, draw a sideways “V” to make the mouth and erase the outside of the circle like this:



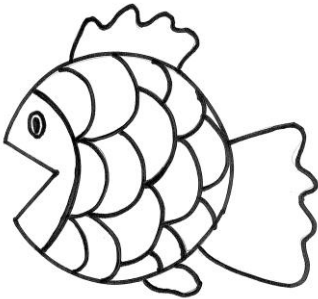
Now we are going to draw a backward stretched out "C" to make the face.



Let add some details: we are going to add the fins, tail and eye.



Next, we are going to add the scales. These are half circles that look like this:



Lastly, let's add some lines, and color as you like!
