## CONTRACTIONS

*Recommended for Ages 7 +*

**Write the contraction word. An example is “she has.” “She’s” is the contraction.**

A contraction is a word, or phrase, that has been shortened by dropping one or more letters and adding an apostrophe. For example, “I have” can be shortened using an apostrophe and dropping the “ha” to create “I’ve.” Other examples include didn’t, isn’t, and can’t.
