HAS, HAVE, HAD

Recommended for Ages 7 +

- **Has** – Present tense (today). Used with *he, she,* and *it*. Example: She *has* a tricycle.
- **Have** – Present tense (today). Used in *I, we,* and *they*. Example: They *have* fun together.
- **Had** – Past tense (yesterday). Used with *he, she, it, I, we,* and *they*. Example: We/I *had* a lot of fun at the park.
