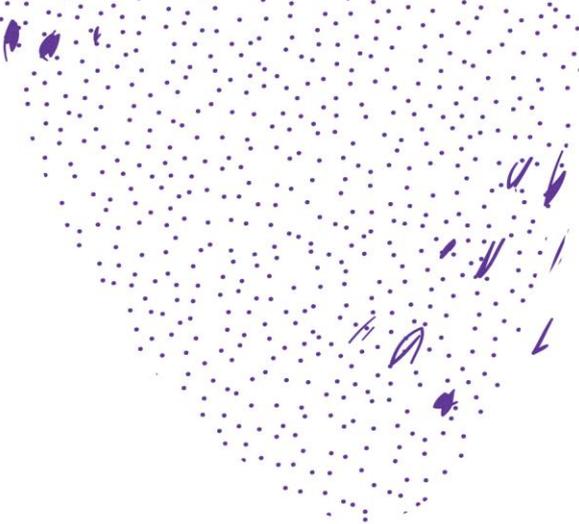




***The Makeup Artists Handbook: Techniques for Film, television, Photography, and Theatre* by Gretchen Davis**

***Behind-the-Scenes: Movie Careers* by Danielle S. Hammelef**


Describes some of the most interesting jobs that take place in the background in the movie industry, and what it takes to make it in the business.


Laptop & Hotspot Loan Kits

Check out a kit with a Chromebook and wireless hotspot to access the internet, from select locations. Borrow for 3 weeks, with the option to renew, if available.




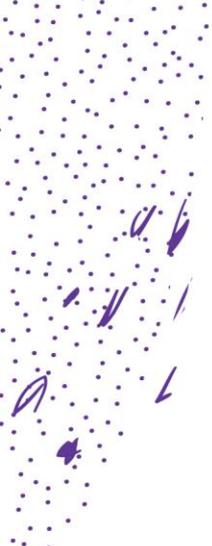
