



The Eye: How the World's Most Influential Creative Directors Develop Their Vision by Nathan Williams







Music Creative Production Jobs

Read more about just a few of the different job roles along the workflow of executing music needs for film and TV

Music Supervisor

A qualified professional who oversees all music related aspects of film, television, advertising, video games and other existing or emerging visual media platforms as required.

Music Coordinators

Supports or works closely with Music Supervisors to fulfill on camera music needs. They may work closely with music editors, composers, and music supervisors to create and deliver cue sheets, ensuring that the film's music royalties are distributed correctly.

Music Clearance Specialists

Administering music clearances for film and TV for publishing and the master recordings, which includes identifying music and lyrics requiring clearances, tracking and researching rights holders, understanding public domain and fair use, legal and license reviews, and building strong relationships.

Business Legal Affairs

Provides legal and strategy support for music production arms of the industry, which may include skills such as drafting and negotiating agreements, coordinating fees, and address any legal issues.



Music Creative Production Jobs (cont.)

Composers

Writes the themes, background score, and source music used in film and TV. Composers may also have writers assistants, production assistants, and apprentices.

Music Editors

Responsible for compiling, editing and syncing music for a film's soundtrack. A music editor will help achieve the director's musical vision on film, ensuring the soundtrack is properly structured and that all the components work perfectly together. They are typically hired by the post-production team, but sometimes showrunners and composers have preferred editors. They may also have assistants or apprentices.

Music Houses/Freelancers or Music Labs

Sometimes an independent music house or freelancers will be hired to fulfill specific music needs or create original work for a part of or entirety of a project if there are no options in a music library or any other existing music available to fit the needs of the project. Companies may also have in-house music labs that can also serve this purpose. Music houses and music labs will have their own full staff including music producers, songwriters, music mixers, editors, etc.

An educational and professional resource for Music Supervisors and those working in related fields across the media spectrum.

American Federation of Musicians Local 47

Labor union that serves to promote and protect the concerns of professional musicians in all areas of the music industry. AFM Local 47 serves musicians working in the counties of Los Angeles (except for Long Beach, covered by AFM Local 353), San Bernardino, Riverside, and Ventura and is an affiliate of the 80,000-member American Federation of Musicians of the United States and Canada, AFL-CIO.





Industry Resources Music Rights

- American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers (ASCAP)
 Performance rights organization that protects its members' musical copyrights by monitoring public performances of their music, whether via a broadcast or live performance and compensating them accordingly.
- Broadcast Music, Inc. (BMI)
 A performance rights organization that collects blanket license fees from businesses that use music, entitling those businesses to play any songs from BMI's repertoire of over 17 million compositions.
