





Maya

3D visual effects software with powerful character creation, rigging, animation, and simulation tools.

Houdini FX

3D procedural software for modeling, rigging, animation, VFX, look development, lighting and rendering in film, TV, advertising and video games. In addition to the full Houdini FX software, there are two other versions:

- ➤ <u>Houdini Apprentice</u> a free version giving access to virtually all the features of the full version but for personal non-commercial projects, letting you save to disk and render out with a word mark.
- ➤ <u>Houdini Indie</u> a more affordable version of the software intended for commercial use for indie filmmakers or game developers.

SynthEyes

A standalone application optimized for camera, object, geometry, and planar tracking, stabilization, and motion capture. Uses for critter insertion, fixing shaky shots, virtual sets, object removal, stereoscopic production, 360°VR, architectural previews, accident reconstruction, product placement, face and body capture, and more.

3D Equalizer

The dominating 3D tracking solution in today's vfx world - merging live action footage with digital visual effects at highest quality possible. It is a cornerstone of modern post-production business and used by virtually all of the major players around the globe working in this field.

Unreal Engine

A popular and widely-used game engine, that you can download for free, with a complete suite of creation tools for game development, architectural and automotive visualization, linear film and television content creation, broadcast and live event production, training and simulation, and other real-time applications.

<u>ShotGrid</u> (formerly Shotgun Software)
 Project management software primarily used for visual effects and animation project management in television shows and movie production and video game development.
