

LA County Library Announces New Hours, Return to 100% Capacity, and In-Person Programs

New Library Schedule will be effective on March 14, 2022

LA County Library is excited to announce that it is expanding its hours of operation across several of its libraries. New and standardized hours of operation will go into effect across its 85 libraries beginning March 14, 2022.

In addition to its new operating hours, LA County Library increased its in-person capacity to 100% earlier this month, while still following the County's mandates regarding physical distancing. Customers and staff are expected to maintain 6-feet of physical distance when in line and when inside the library. The Library has also resumed in-person events and programs across its libraries.
