The artwork promotes a passion for learning that can be passed through generations, and acknowledges the technological advancements that continue to change the way we discover, learn and communicate.



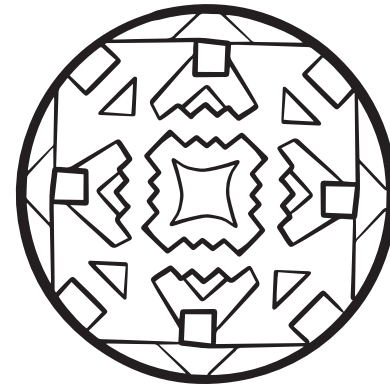
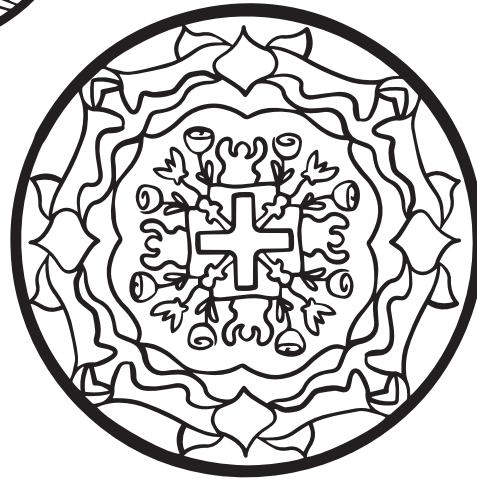
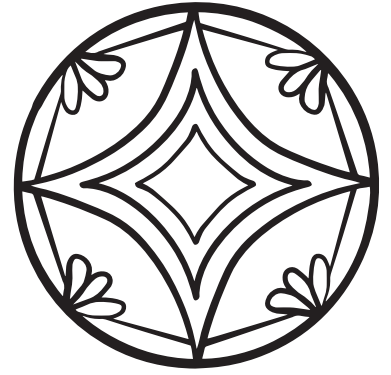
